- b. Guided Nine Mile Tour: Nine Mile Canyon is 70 miles long, on the way to Range Creek! Journey through Utah's historic Nine Mile Canyon and explore the landscape of rock, discover the rock art of ancient people, and travel the road used by the Utes, the military, the freighters, the ranchers, and all manner of explorers, both ancient and modern. Successions of people and cultures have lived in Nine Mile Canyon for at least 8,000 years. See the legacy of rock art preserved from prehistoric cultures and recently, the Utes.
- c. Range Creek Tour: You've heard all the hype about the "Lost Canyon," now experience it! We provide a limited number of people an opportunity to see this unique place; you will be part of the first guided tours! Readers Digest describes Range Creek, "Lush undergrowth hugs the swift-moving central creek, and the land is dotted with outcroppings of stone and stands of cottonwood, spruce and box elders. An in the heart of the valley is promontory topped by what resembles an old-time locomotive fashioned from massive red rocks stacked one upon another by the sheer force of nature." You will see many relics from Native life including granaries and pictographs.
