

session description










Do you identify as LGBTQ+?

a few comments that struck me

how CUWiP signals inclusiveness

 some genderqueer students registered as women because they feared they wouldn't be accepted to the conference if they told the truth about their gender identity ("It's a women's conference")

intersectionality is hugely important

- queer women of color are isolated on three counts

bad department culture is often because of other students, not professors

- physics clubs (e.g. SPS chapters) can be especially bad
- can department administration / faculty do something to help?
