

# AAPT/AIP Master Teacher Policy Fellowship

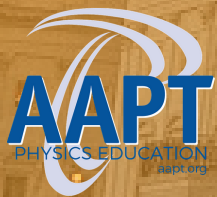
## 6-13 JULY 2019
