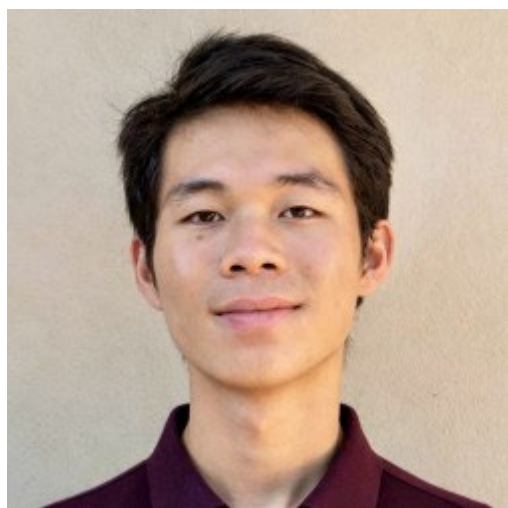


2026 U.S. Physics Team Training and Development Camp — Successful Campers

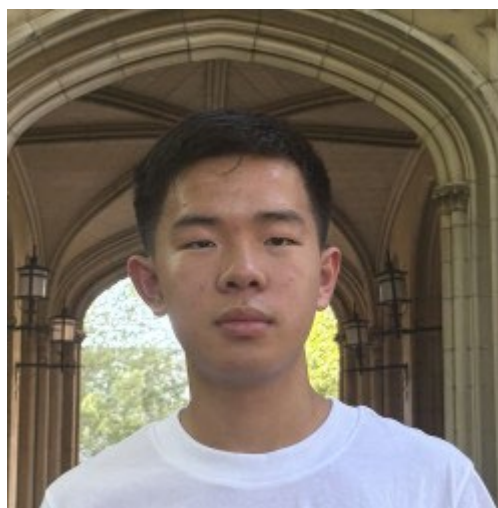

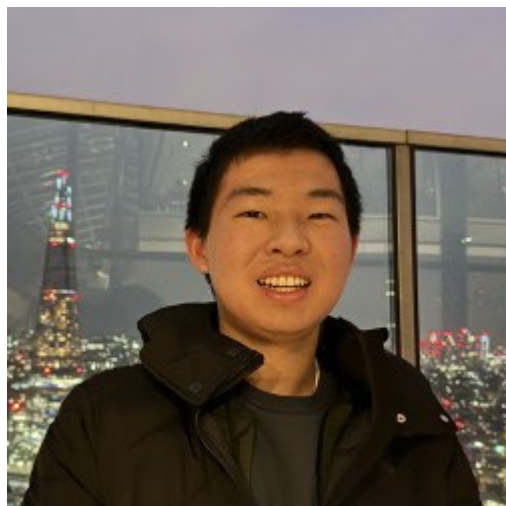

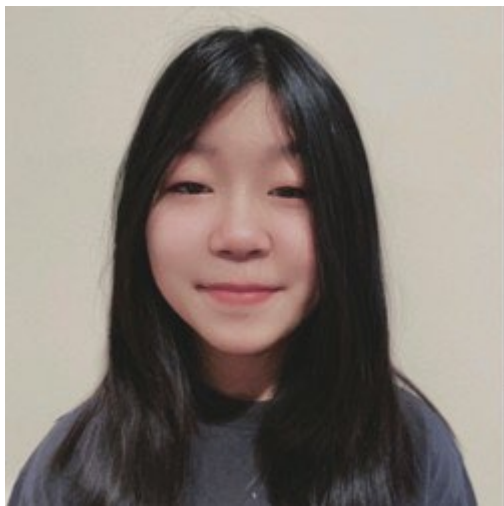
